Dear Students and Parents,

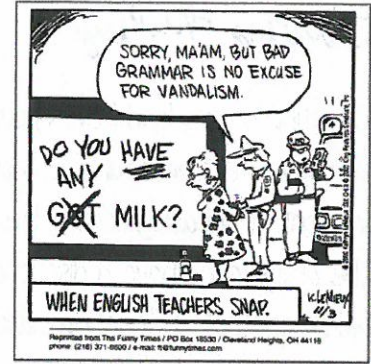

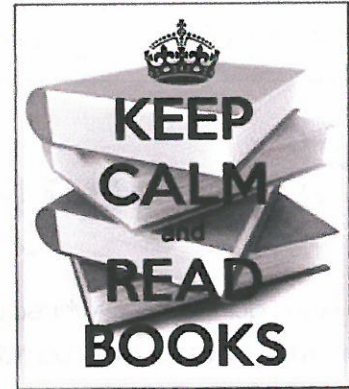
